2^d Then the Town took the second Article and Ordered their Committee already appointed to procure the men referred to in this Article on as good terms as they can -

Then the Town by their Vote adjourned this meeting to Monday y^e 2^d day of July next at 2 o'clock after noon at this place -

Monday July 2^d the Town being met according to adjournment proceeded and took up the third Article then passed over it for the present -

4th Article chose the Selectmen a Committee to make a division with East Sudbury of the men required of the Towns of Sudbury & East Sudbury for three years by a resolve of the Gen^l Court of y^e 2^d December 1780 - Also their Quota of twenty seven hundred men required for three months in order to reinforce the Continental Army - Also to make division of Clothing, Bay & required of said Towns - & to report at the adjournment of this meeting

5th Article Ordered the select men to draw out of the forty thousand pound, granted for the purpose of hiring men for three years agreeable to a resolve of the Gen^l Court of y^e 2^d of December 1780, for the support of the poor untill further Order of the Town -

Then the town took up the first Article again and appointed the Militia Officers a Committee to hire the men referred to in this Article either for six months or for three years

Then the town took up the second Article again and Ordered the above Committee to hire the two men required for Rhode Island -

Then the town adjourned this ^{meeting} to Friday y^e 6th Inst at 4 o'clock after noon at this place

Friday 6 July the town being met according to adjournment took up the fourth Article again & chose Mr Abijah Brigham, Mr Ben^{on} Smith & Col^l Ezekiel How a Committee to procure and deliver the Bay agreeable the resolve of the Gen^l Court of y^e 22^d June and granted the sum of one hundred and thirty four pounds in specie or in bills of Credit that shall be fully equal in value thereto, to enable sd^o Committee
