1st To Choose a Moderator and bring in Town Debts and Credit

2 To see if the Town will Grant to their Reverend Minister his salary for the year ensuing -----

3 To see if the Town will Grant Money for the Support of a Grammar School the ensuing year & Order where the same shall be kept -----

4 To see if the Town will Grant money for the Support of a Reading & writing School the year ensuing & Order where the same shall be kept -----

5 To see if the Town will Grant money for the Relief of the Poor in said Town the year ensuing -----

6 To see if the Town will Grant Money to pay their Rectors and Town Treasurer the present year -----

7 To see if the Town will Appoint a Man to take Care of and sweep the Meeting House & dig Graves as there may be occasion the year ensuing -----

8 To see if the Town will Grant Money to supply the Families of the Continental Soldiers belonging to this Town with Necessaries agreeable to the Resolves of the General Court -----

9 To see if the Town will Grant Money to enable their Committee to provide this Town's Quota of Beef for the supply of the Army agreeable to a Resolue of the General Court -----

10 To see if the Town will make provision for enabling their Treasurer to discharge the several Obligations by him given, by Order of, and in behalf of the Town, to sundry persons for enlisting themselves to serve as Soldiers for said Town -----

11 To see if the Town will Grant Money to build a Pound, or do or act as they shall think proper when met -----

12 To see if the Town will Grant money to build a Work House and lay up provisions for the poor, do or act as they shall think proper -----

13 To see if the Town will petition the General Court for Relief from the Burthen they are subjected to in being compelled to keep in repair and maintain one half of the Bridges and long Causeways near Mr Jon^s Carters in East Sudbury. do or

14 To see if the Town will make provision for discharging the Debts contracted by their Committees in years past for the purpose of hiring men into the Service do or act as they shall think proper when met -----
