- Then the Town took up 4th Article again & voted to build a Pound & chose Capt Elijah Smith, St Joseph Miller & William Rice a Committee to view and pitch upon a place suitable to build a Pound on; also to consider what materials will be best to build with; and to estimate the Cost of building; and to report to the town at the adjournment of this Meeting
- 13 The Town voted to petition the General Court for relief from the Burthen complained of as set forth in this Article; and chose Col^o Rice, then the Town excused Col^o Rice from this service and chose Capt Asahel Wheeler Capt Moses Stone & William Rice a Committee for the purpose aforesaid; and Granted the sum of six pound to enable a Committee to prosecute the same - - - 6 - 0 - 0

Then the Town adjourned this Meeting to Monday 4th Day of Novem^r next at one o Clock P. M. at this place

Monday Novem^r 5th the Town being met according to the foregoing adjournments proceeded as follows

- 14 Voted to choose a Committee to examine into the Debts referred to in this Article & to report to the town at the adjournment of this meeting; and chose Dea^r Plympton, Mr Tho Walker, and Capt Aaron Haynes for the purpose aforesaid; then the town excused Dea^r Plympton and chose Capt Joseph Goodenow in his room -
