Then the Town took up the 11 Article again &
accepted the Report of their Committee which was
as follows viz: that the pound may be built on the
Common at the south end of Lt Elisha Wheelers Sta-
ble adjoining Easterly on Mr Lyndfields Land, and
that stone will be most suitable to build with --

Then the town ordered the same Committee to
consider the Dimensions that will be proper to build
sd pound, height & breadth of the wall &c. and to report
to the town at the Adjournment of this meeting

Then the town Granted to their Committee for
hiring the first ten men for setting up the Conti-
nental Army for three Years or during the war four
pound ten shillings ----- 4- 10- 0

Then the town Adjourned this meeting to Monday
the 19 Inst at 2 o Clock P.M. at the Meeting House

Monday Nov^r 19 the Town being met according to
the foregoing Adjournment proceeded to allow the following
Accounts viz: to Doct^r Josiah Langdons Administratrix
for his Dautering Mrs Crosby sick of the Low Venere in
March 1778 one pound. Ditto for Dautering Sarah
Cory in Nov^r 1777 eight shillings & seven pence
ditto for Dautering Mrs Knight in Sept^r 1774
