

To Hopstall Willis for 104 feet of plank, twelve shillings
and six pence ----- 12-6

To the Committee Appointed to hire three Year, six months,
five months, & three months men four pound ten shilling - 10-0

Then the town took up the 11 Article again and heard the
Report of their Committee respecting the building a pound
and Ordered said pound to be built on the Ground before
Agreed on said pound to be built with Stone. the wall
to be 6 feet high 3 1/2 thick at bottom & gradually
narrowed till it comes to 1 1/2 feet thick at the top to be
built 30 feet square the inside & to have timbers, either
hewed or sawed three square, locked on the top; and
chose Mess^{rs} John Brigham, ^{and Aaron Johnson} Howard Bogle, a Com-
mittee to see to the building said pound, & Committee
to give public Notice at some convenient time, that
any person disposed to ~~undertake~~ to build said pound
may have an opportunity to undertake the same
preferance to be given to such as will do it cheapest
to the acceptance of sd Committee

Then the town allowed the following Amounts viz:

To their Committee for making a Division of Debts and
property between the towns of Sudbury and East Sud-
bury six pounds. ----- 6-0-0

To Aaron Haynes for keeping Sarah Cory six weeks &
five days in the Year 1778 - two pound ----- 2-0-0

To Howard Bogle for warning one town meeting in 1780
& for outfitting & transporting Katharine McDowell
& son to East Sudbury - ten shilling. ----- 10-0

Then the town Adjourned this meeting to Mr Aaron Johnsons

The town being met according to the foregoing Adjournment
took up the 14 Article and Granted, for the purpose
expressed in this Article viz to enable their Committee to
discharge the Debts by them contracted in years past for
the purpose of hiring men into the service, three hun-
dred & six pound thirteen shilling & ten pence - 306-13-10

Then the town took up the 5th Article again and made
an additional Grant of forty pound for the supports
of the poor the ensuing Year ----- 40-0-0

Then the town by their Vote Ordered the money Granted
at this meeting to be made into a Note forth with
