Then the town took up the 12th Article again & appointed the selectmen a Committee to purchase a part of the store in Sudbury, when to be sold, in order, therewith, to make a work house

Then the town by their vote dissolved this meeting

- These are to Notify and Warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of Sudbury Qualified as the Law directs to Vote in Town affairs to meet at the meeting House in said Town on Monday the fourth Day of March next at one o'clock after noon on said Day then and there
- 1 To choose a Moderator, Selectmen, Town Clerk, Town Treasurer, Apsesors, Constables, and all other Town officers required by Law to be annually chosen in the month of March
 - 2 To see if the Town will build a Work House or other ways provide a place for the reception of the Poor in said Town
 - 3 To see if the Town will give Liberty for swine to go at large the present year
 - 4 To see if the Town will repair their highways by a Rate the present year and grant a suitable sum of money for repairing the same and order the Apsesors to make the same into a Rate forthwith and empower the Surveyors to collect said Rate
 - 5 To see if the Town will give Liberty for Horses to go at Large without fetters any part of the present year from the first day of April next to last day of September next
 - 6 To see if the Town will give Liberty for sheep to go at Large from the fifteenth day of March next to the first day of May next
 - 7 To see if the Town will accept of the List of Jurors as they are put into the Box by the Selectmen
 - 8 To see if the Town will accept of the Settlements of the Selectmen with the Town Treasurer
 - 9 To see if the Town will reconsider their order for building a Pound with Stone and order said Pound to be built with wood agreeable to the request of their Committee appointed for the purpose of building said Pound
 - 10 To see if the Town will point out the particular Debts intended to be discharged by their Grant of Three Hundred
