- 11 To see if the Town will order what shall be done with the paper Money that may be remaining in the Treasury
- 12 To see if the Town will accept of and confirm the agreement ~~chosen by~~ of the Committee chosen by Sudbury and East Sudbury to make a Division of all what is to be divided between the ~~two~~ two Towns of Sudbury and East Sudbury agreeable to an Act of the General Court for Incorporating the Town of East Sudbury
- 13 To see if the Town will discontinue and sell a Town way leading from the road that goes from Jewels Mill through the land of Mess^{rs} Benj^m & Jon^a Smiths to How line; do or act as the Town shall think proper when met.
- 14 To see if the Town will hear and accept the Report of their Committee appointed at a former meeting for the purpose of settling the line between the Lands of Coll^r How. Esq^r Richardson and the Town do or act as the Town shall think proper when met
- 15 To see if the Town will in such way as to them shall appear most proper make provision for furnishing themselves with a Standard of Weight & Measures
