- 13 Voted to Choose a Committee to view the Road referred to in this Article and to report to the town at their next April Meeting; & chose Mr Tho Walker, A Oliver Noyes & M<sup>r</sup> Uriah Hayden a Committee for the purpose aforesaid
- 14 Referred the Consideration of the Report referred to in this Article to some future Town meeting
- 15 Ordered the Selectmen to provide the weights and measures referred to in this Article

Then the Town Adjourned this Meeting to Wednesday y<sup>e</sup> 13 Inst at 3 o'clock after Noon at the House of M<sup>r</sup> Aaron Johnson Inn holder in S<sup>d</sup> Town
