- At a legal Town Meeting in Sudbury May 4. 1782
1 The Town being met at time & place agreeable to the foregoing
warning proceeded as follows viz; the Question being put
to see if the Town will choose some meet person to represent
the Town in a Great & General Court the present Year as set forth
in the above Warning. --- The Vote passed in the negative ---
2 Chose Col^d Jonathan Nye their Moderator, and appointed their
former Committee Viz. Col^d Nye. Capt Haynes, Capt Wheeler,
Capt Knight & Capt Goodenow, a Committee to agree with
Capt Haynes respecting the Note referred to in this Article
3 Article appointed the Selectmen a Committee with full
power to transact with East Sudbury, the Business referred
to in this Article - - - - -

Then the Town took up the second Article again and Granted
twenty seven shilling per head for the seventeen Cattle
mentioned in the Note referred to, amounting, in the whole,
to twenty two pound nineteen shillings, and ordered the
same to be paid out of the unappropriated Money belonging
to the Town; - - - - -

Then the Town by their Vote, & dissolved this Meeting
