To choose a Moderator and adopt such measures as to them shall appear best calculated to expedite the Collection and Payment of the Continental Tax granted in March last; Also to procure a loan of such further sums of Money (for a few months only) as their respective Circumstances will possibly admit of; agreeable to an Act of the Genl Court of July 4th - 1782; together with circular Letters to the Selectmen directed and Ordered to be communicated to the Inhabitants

August 5th 1782 the Town by their Vote accepted the warning of this meeting -

August 5. 1782 at a legal Town meeting in Sudbury the town being met at time & place according to the foregoing warning provided and chose William Rie their Moderator

Then the town by their Vote ordered the Selectmen to call upon the Constables to exert themselves to collect so much of the continental Tax, referred to in the above warning, as they possibly can between this & the 27th day of August Inst. and on 3d day to attend at the House of Ezekiel How Esq^r Innholder in sd Town, in order to pay the same to John Gleason Esq^r Agent for the County of Middlesex agreeable to an Order of the Genl Court of the 4th of July 1782

Then the Town by their Vote dissolved this meeting
