- There are to notify and warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of the town of Sudbury Qualified as the Law directs to Vote in town affairs to meet at the Meeting-House in said town on Monday the 15th day of Octo^r Inst^t at 1 o Clock after noon then & there
- 1 To choose a Moderator & bring in town Debts and Credit.
 - 2 To see if the town will take under Consideration a circular Letter from the town of Boston directed to the Selectmen to be communicated; do or act thereon as they shall think proper
 - 3 To see if the town will grant to their Rev^d Minister his Salary for the year ensuing
 - 4 To see if the town will grant money for the support of a Grammar school the ensuing year and order where the same shall be kept
 - 5 To see if the town will grant money for the support of a reading & writing school the ensuing year and order where the same shall be kept
 - 6 To see if the town will grant money for the relief of the Poor in said town the ensuing year
 - 7 To see if the town will grant money to pay their Assessors and Town Treasurer the present year
 - 8 To see if the town will appoint a Man to take Care of and sweep the Meeting-house and dig Graves as occasion may be the year ensuing
 - 9 To see if the town will grant money to pay the several Obligations (which may become due in the course of the year) given by their Treasurer to sundry persons for enlisting themselves as Soldiers for said town
 - 10 To see if the town will make provision for relieving their six months men now in service
 - 11 To see if the town will grant money to pay Nathaniel Cutter and others for a Quantity of Rice promised them for the time they were detained in service (the year past beyond the time agreed for
 - 12 To see if the town will make provision for repairing the Bridge near Mr^r Carters in Sudbury do or act as they shall think proper when met
