14th October 1782 the town by their vote accepted the warning
of this Meeting -----

At a legal town meeting held in Duxbury of 14th Octo^r 1782
The town being met agreeable to the foregoing warning provided
and chose Capt. Asahel Wheeler Moderator -----

Then the town took under Consideration the circular Letter
referred to in the 2^d Article of the warning of this meeting
and passed over the same -----

3 Article Granted to ^{the} ~~their~~ Reverend Mr Jacob Biglow of
Seventy four pounds for his salary of ensuing year L^y 74-0-0

4 Article passed in the negative -----

5 -- Granted fifty pounds for the support of a
reading and writing school and ordered the
same to be equally divided between the five school-
houses in D town -----

6 -- Granted fifty pounds for the relief of the poor
the ensuing year ----- 50-0-0

7 (Granted six pounds to pay their expenses of present year 6-0-0

(Granted four pounds to pay their Treasurer of present year 4-0-0

8 Appointed John Green to take Care of sweep the
Meeting house; and dig Graves (as occasion may be)
the year ensuing -----

9 Article passed over for the present -----

10 Chose the Militia Officer a Committee to pro-
-cure the men referred to in this Article -----

Then the town by their vote adjourned this Meeting to
Monday of 21st Ins^t at 1 O'Clock after noon at this
place -----

Octo^r 21st 1782 The town being met according to
the foregoing adjournment provided & took up the

9 Article again; which passed in the negative -----

Then the town took up the 10th Article again and ordered

for the service referred to in this Article such sum, or
sums, out of the unappropriated money that may
be in the Treasury as the Committee shall order, before
their marching; Also, to give his Obligations, in behalf
of the town, for such further sum or, sums of
money as the Committee shall order -----
