11 Article passed over for the present —

12 Article. Ordered the Selectmen to repair the Bridges refered to in this Article and bring their Accounts to the town for doing the same at the adjournment of this meeting —

Then the town took up the first Article and granted Eighteen pounds twelve shillings to Nathaniel Cutler to pay him for a Quantity of Rice refered to in the 11th Article —

Then the town took up the 5th Article again and reconsidered their Grant of fifty pounds for the support of a reading & writing school the ensuing year —

Then the town took up the 1st Article again and granted fifty pound for the support of a Grammar school the ensuing year; to be equally divided between the five school houses in D town, each Quarter to provide a Master as such times as they shall think best —

Then the town reconsidered their Grant of fifty pound for the support of a Grammar school the ensuing year —

Then the town granted twelve pound for the support of a Grammar school the ensuing year and ordered the same to be kept in the school house in the Northeast Quarter of D town —

12-0-0

Then the town took up the 5th Article again & granted forty eight pound for the support of a ~~Grammar school the year ensuing~~ reading & writing school the year ensuing to be equally divided between the remaining four school houses in D town each Quarter to provide their own Master —

48-0-0

Then the town adjourned this meeting to Monday the 11th day of Novem^r next at 4 o'clock after noon at this place —
