These are to Notify and warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of Sudbury Qualified as the Law directs to Vote in Town affairs to meet at the Meeting House in said Town on Monday the third Day of March next at one o'clock after noon on said Day then and there

- 1 To choose a Moderator, Selectmen, Overseers of the poor, Town Clerk, Town Treasurer, Assessor, Constables, all other Officers required by Law annually to be chosen in the month of March
- 2 To see if the Town will build a Work House or other way, provide a place for the reception of the Poor in said Town
- 3 To see if the Town will give Liberty for Swine to go at large the present year
- 4 To see if the Town will repair their Highways by a Rate the present year and grant a suitable sum of Money for repairing the same and order the Assessors to make the same into a Rate forthwith and empower the Surveyors to Collect said Rate
- 5 To see if the Town will give Liberty for Horses to go at large without fetters any part of the present year from the first Day of April next to the last Day of September next
- 6 To see if the Town will give Liberty for Sheep to go at large from the fifteenth Day of March next till the first Day of May next
- 7 To see if the Town will accept of the List of Jurors as they are put into the Box by the Selectmen
- 8 To see if the Town will accept of the Settlements of the Selectmen with the Town Treasurer
- 9 To see if the Town will make provision for paying Col^o Rice the Balance reported to be due to him in the Division of Debts and property between the Towns of Sudbury and East Sudbury do or act as they shall think proper when met
