Then the Town chose Mr Peter Haynes a Constable
in the room of Uriah Farmer

3 Article Gave Liberty for Swine to go at large the present
Year they being Yoked & winged

4 Voted to repair their Highways by a Rate the present
Year and granted the sum of Forty pound for the
purpose and ordered the Assessors to make the same into
Rate forthwith and appointed the Surveyors Collectors
of said Rate

5 Passed in the Negative

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7 Accepted of the List of Jurors as put into the Box by
the Selectmen

8 Accepted the Settlement of the Selectmen with the
Town Treasurer as hereafter recorded

9 Voted to pay Col^d Rice the endorsement of the Notes
with Interest from the time the Notes were given

10 Article acted upon as before recorded

11 Voted to discharge Mr Ashur Cutler from the sum of
money mentioned he giving up to the Selectmen the order
referred to in this Article

Then the Town by their Vote dissolved this Meeting
