- 5 To see if the Town will give Liberty for sheep to go at Large from the fifteenth day of March next to the first day of May next
- 6 To see if the Town will except of the List of Jurors as they are put into the Box by the Selectmen
- 7 To see if the Town will except of the Settlement of the Selectmen with the Town Treasurer
- 8 To see if the Town will make provision for paying Daniel Lincoln and others for a number of Cattle promised them for enlisting themselves into the Service of the United States for the Term of three Years; do or act as the Town shall think proper when met
- 9 To see if the Town agreeable to the Request of Elisha Wheeler and others will petition the General Court for a Lottery to repair the Causeways & Bridges that lie in Sudbury and East Sudbury; do or act as the Town shall think proper when met
- 10 To see if the Town will discontinue a highway leading from Frammingham Line to the great Road near the Saltrumples till D way comes to the north Side of the Brook against Col^d Hows Pasture do or act as they shall think proper when met
- M To see if the Town will call upon those Persons who are indebted to D^d Town on Bond Note or otherways to pay their several dues, do or act as the Town shall think proper when met
