At a Town meeting of the Qualified Inhabitants legally assembled in Sudbury on Monday the 5th Day of April A 1784 at 2 of the Clock after noon for the purpose of choosing a Governor, Lieut Governor and Senators for the Year ensuing: (and of all others Qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town Affairs) Said Inhabitants brought in their Votes as follows

For the Hon: Oliver Prescott Esq^r --- 23

Votes for a Lieut Governor
