House in Boston on Wednesday the 26th Day of May
Instant agreeable to the Constitution of the Common-
wealth of Massachusetts

- 2 Chose Coll Donathen Rice their Moderator
then the Town proceeded to the ^{Consideration of} remaining parts
of this Article which passed in the negative
- 3 The Town appointed the Selectmen a Committee
to repair the Bridges referred to in this Article in
such way and manner as they shall think best
- 4 Article passed in the negative
- 5 Article ordered the Note referred to in this Article to
be delivered to Sybil Mofman Iose Mofman and
Dyra Mofman Giving Bond to indemnify the Town
from any Charges that may arise on account of
a Female Bastard Child of the sd Sybil's till sd
Child shall arrive the full age of seven years
- 6 Article ordered the Treasurer to return the dupli-
cate Receipts which have been taken for Beef
agreeable to sundry Resolves of the General Court
to the Governor and Council and take such further
Measures as ~~may be~~ he may think necessary to
save the Town harmless

Then the Town by their Vote dissolved this Meeting
