These are to Notify and warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudburyland as the Law directs to vote in Town affairs to meet at the Meeting house in said Town on Monday the 11th Day of October next at 1 of the Clock after noon on said Day then and there

- 1st To choofe a Moderator and bring in Town Debts and Credit
- 2 To see if the Town will grant to their Rev^d Minister his Salary for the Year ensuing
- 3 To see if the Town will grant money for the Support of a Grammar School the ensuing Year and order where the same shall be kept
- 4 To see if the Town will Grant money for the Support of a Reading and writing School the ensuing Year and order where the same shall be kept
- 5 To see if the Town will grant money for the relief of the Poor ~~the~~ in said Town the Year ensuing
- 6 To see if the Town will grant money to pay their Apportion and Town Treasurer the present Year
- 7 To see if the Town will appoint a man to take Care of and Sweep the Meeting house and dig Graves as Occasion may be the ensuing Year
- 8 To see if the Town will give any further orders respecting the Collection of Debts due to the Town whether in the hands of former Constables or others do or act as they shall think proper when met
- 9 To see if the Town will sell the Ministerial Land near Doct^r Hopmans and give a Title thereto do or act as they shall think proper when met
- 10 To see if the Town will appoint an Agent or Agents to appear in their behalf before the Court of General Sessions of the Peace to answer a Complaint said to be exhibited by the Town of Bolton against the Town of Sudbury for sending Mary Piper and three Children from said Sudbury to said Bolton do or act as they shall think proper when met
- 11 To see if the Town will choofe an Agent or Agents to defend them against an Action brought against said Town by Thomas Dalrimple now pending in the Court of Common Pleas do or act as they shall think proper when met
