Then the Town took up the 13th Article again and reconsidered their Vote for choosing Agents for the purpose set forth in this Article and agreed with Mr Isaac Puffer and others Petitioners for the Road referred to in this Article.

That the further Consideration of the matter be referred to a Committee of three disinterested Persons to view said Road at the Expense of the Petitioners and if they think proper to lay out the same the Petitioners to indemnify the Town of Sudbury from all Costs and Charges that shall arise in paying for the Land that may be taken for said Road except so far as said Road may go through the Land of Capt Daniel Bowker and St Joseph ~~Lee~~ Heywood and Ephraim Wood of Concord Esq Jonathan Wood of Stow Esq and Josiah Stone of Frammingham Esq. are mutually agreed upon by the Inhabitants of Sudbury in Town meeting Assented and the Petitioners aforesaid for the purpose aforesaid and all further proceedings on the part of the Petitioners to be made in the mean time
