These are to notify & warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury who are qualified as the Law directs to vote in the Choice of a Representative to meet at the Meeting House in said Sudbury on Monday the 27<sup>th</sup> of December Instant at 2 of the Clock in the after noon then and there to give their Votes for a Register of Deeds for the County of Middlesex

The Town being met at time and place agreeable to the foregoing warning accepted the warning of this meeting & proceeded as hereafter recorded - - - - -

December the 27<sup>th</sup> 1784 at a meeting of the Qualified Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury regularly assembled for the purpose of bringing <sup>in</sup> their Votes for a Register of Deeds for the County of Middlesex <sup>said Inhabitants</sup> proceeded to bring their votes and brought their Votes in as follows viz:
