These are to notify and warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of Sudbury who are Qualified as the Law directs to Vote in Town affairs to meet the Meeting house in sd Sudbury on Monday the 7th day of March next at 1 of the Clock in the afternoon on said Day then and there

- 1 To choose a Moderator, Selectmen Town Clerk, Town Treasurer, Assessors, Constables, and all other Town Officers required by Law to be annually chosen in the Month of March
- 2 To see if the Town will repair their Highways by a Rate the present Year and grant a suitable Sum of money for repairing the same and order the Assessors to make the same into a Rate forthwith do or act as the Town shall think proper when met
- 3 To see if the Town will select a number of suitable Persons to be put into the Boxes for Jurors agreeable to a Law of the Commonwealth in that Case made and provided
- 4 To see if the Town will give Liberty for Swine to go at Large the present Year
- 5 To see if the Town will give Liberty for Horses to go at Large ~~the present Year~~ without Tether any part of the present Year from the first day of April next to the last day of September next
- 6 To see if the Town will give Liberty for Sheep to go at Large from the fifteenth Day of March next to the first Day of May next
- 7 To see if the Town will accept of the Settlement of the Selectmen with the Town Treasurer
- 8 To see if the Town will give leave to move the Schoolhouse in Lenham to such place as the Quarter shall agree upon said Quarter being at the Expence of moving the same agreeable to the Petition of Josiah Richardson and others
- 9 To see if the Town agreeable to the request of Capt Stone will make satisfaction for a Piece of Land by him said to be taken from Mr Storer and applied to the Towns use
- 10 To see if the Town agreeable to the Petition of Dant Bowker and others will oppose a County Road as laid out
