- 4 To see if the Town will appoint a Committee to proportion the Inhabitants of sd Town to the several Schoolhouses within the same do or act as they may think proper when met
- 5 To see if the Town will make provision for repairing Shurmans Bridge so called do or act as they may think proper when met
- 6 To see if the Town will take Measures in order to recover Costs of the Town of Bolton for keeping the Wid^d Piper and Children together with Contingent Charges do or act as the Town may think proper when met
- 7 To see if the Town will take Measures in order to settle the Accounts of Asahel Wheeler and William Rice for their Services and Money expended in defending the Town against the Actions of Luther Innes Tho Galvin-ple and the Town of Bolton and make provision for paying the Balance that may be found due to them do or act as the Town may think proper when met
