These are to notify and warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury Qualified as the Law directs to Vote in Town Affairs to meet at the Meeting House in said Sudbury on Monday the 7th Day of November next at 1 of the Clock in the afternoon then & there

- 1 To Choose a Moderator & bring in Town Debts & Credit
- 2 To see if the Town will Grant to their Rev^d Minister his Salary for the Year ensuing
- 3 To see if the Town will Grant Money for the Support of a Grammar School the ensuing Year & Order where the same shall be kept
- 4 To see if the Town will Grant Money for the Support of a Reading & writing School the ensuing Year & order where the same shall be kept
- 5 To see if the Town will Grant money for the Relief of the Poor in sd Town the Year ensuing
- 6 To see if the Town will Grant money to pay their Assessors & Treasurer the present Year
- 7 To see if the Town will appoint a Man to take Care of & Sweep the Meeting House, ring the Bell, & Dig Graves as Occasion may be the ensuing Year
- 8 To see if the Town will Attend to & accept the Report of their Committee Appointed in May last to proposition the Inhabitants of sd Town to the several School-Houses within sd Town, do or act as the Town shall think proper when met
- 9 To see if the Town will take measures to free themselves from the Burthen of Supporting Joseph Green do or act as they shall think fit when met
- 10 To see if the Town will hear and accept the Report of their Committee appointed at a former Meeting for the purpose of examining the Claim of Mr Storor to Land said to be taken from him and converted to the Towns use do or act as the Town shall think proper when met
- 11 To see if the Town will Discharge Mr James Thompson their late Treasurer from a Sum of Money due to said Town he giving up a Note for the same Sum signed by Capt Heard and others do or act as the Town shall think proper when met
