The Town by their Vote accepted the warning of this Meeting

At a Town Meeting legally warned & held in Sudbury on Monday the 7th Day of November A^d 1785 at 1 o'clock in the Afternoon the Town being met according to the foregoing Warning proceeded as follows viz:

Artic^l 1st Choose Coll. Jonathan Rice their Moderator; then Allow Mr John Maynard for a journey to Boston, fees paid Mr Sullivan & settling Accounts with the Town £ 1 0

2 Committee One pound five shillings & eight pence 1-5-8

3 Granted the Rev^d Mr Biglow for his Salary the ensuing Year Seventy four pounds 74

Granted for the support of a Grammar School the ensuing Year eight pound and ordered the same to be kept in the School

House near the Meeting House in sd Town

Allowed Mr Edmund Parmenter for Jonas Bakers

poll tax in the Year 1767, ten shillings & six pence 10-6

Then the Town took up the second Article again & reconsidered their Grant of eight pound &

Granted the sum of Forty pound for the purpose set forth in sd Article & ordered the same to be

equally divided amongst the several School-Houses in sd Town, said Forty pound to be

expended within six months from the Grant 40

6 Granted to pay their Assessor Four pounds 4

Granted to pay their Treasurer Two pounds 2

Allow En^r Josiah Richardson one pound seventeen shillings & seven pence V^l Currency to be deducted from the Balance due from him to said Town

Adjusted in settlement made March 1786
