 service five shillings 5.

To William Hayden for Tho^s Goodenows Rates in the
 Year 1782 One pound six Shillings & five pence 1-6-5.

To Ditto for Ashbel Moore Rates in the Year 1782
 seventeen Shillings & four pence 17 4.

To John Brigham for Timber Irons & Carpenter
 one day to repair the Gate at the Burying Yard
 & 1/2 days work himself at the Meeting House
 Twelve Shillings 12.

To Capt Sam^l Knight eight Shillings in full for
 his service as an Apepor in the Year 1784 8.

To Capt Joseph Goodenow for warning one Town Meeting 4.
