These are to notify & warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury who are Qualified as the Law directs to Vote in Town affairs to meet at the Meeting House in said Sudbury on Monday the 6th Day of March next at 1 of the Clock Afternoon on ^{sd} Day then & there

- 1st To Choose a Moderator, Selectmen, Town Clerk, Town Treasurer, Assessors, Constables & all other Town Officers by Law required to be annually chosen in the Month of March
- 2 To bring in their Votes for a County Register of Deeds agreeable to a Law of this Commonwealth in that behalf made & provided
- 3 To see if the Town will repair their Highways by a Rate the present year & Grant a suitable sum of money for repairing the same & order the Assessors to make the same into a Rate forthwith do or act as the Town shall think proper when met
- 4 To see if the Town will give Liberty for Swine to go at large the present year.
- 5 To see if the Town will give Liberty for Horses to go at large without fetters any part of the present year from the first day April next to the last Day of September next
- 6 To see if the Town will give Liberty for Sheep to go at large from the fifteenth day of March next to the first day of May next
- 7th To see if the Town will accept of the settlement of the Selectmen with the Town Treasurer
- 8th To see if the Town will make provision for Discharging an Indenture in favour of Capt Daniel Bouker & St Joseph Hayward against sd Town do or act as they shall think proper when met
- 9 To see if the Town will accept the Report of their Committee appointed at a former Meeting for the purpose of settling with the Town of Bolton for keeping the Wid^o Piper & Children do or act as the Town shall think proper when met
- 10 To see if the Town agreeable to the Petition of Saml Puffer and others will in future let out the
