Then the Town Adjourned this Meeting to Monday the 27th day of March Inst at 5 of the Clock afternoon to the Dwelling House of M^r Aaron Johnsons Innholder in S^d Town

Monday 27 of March 1786 The Town being met at three & place according to the foregoing Adjournment proceeded & Incused M^r Aaron Goodenow Jun^r from serving Constable the present year. Then Chose M^r Isaac Lincoln Jun^r a Constable for the present year. who refused to accept the office

Then the Town Chose Col. Ezekiel How a Constable for the present year -

Then the Town Chose M^r John Maynard an Overseer of the poor in the room of M^r Benj^m Smith who refused to serve in the office

Then the Town Chose M^r Timothy Innes an Overseer of the poor in the room of M^r John Maynard who refused to serve in S^d Office

Then the Town by their Vote Dissolved this Meeting
