There are to Notify & warn all the male Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury Qualified as is provided by the Constitution to vote in the Choice of a Governor, Lieut Governor & Senators; And all others Qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town Affairs to meet at the Meeting House in sd Town on Monday the 3^d day of April next at 1 of the Clock afternoon on sd day then and there

- 1 To bring in their Votes for a Governor, Lt Governor & Senators for the Year ensuing
- 2 To Choose a Moderator and to act on the 7th 9th 11th Articles referred from the warning of March Meeting Inst to said April Meeting
- 3 To see if the Town agreeable to the Request of Mr John Maynard & Doct Moses Taft will sell to said Maynard and Taft a part of the Meeting House Lot so called in order to straighten the line between the Lands of said Maynard & Taft & said Lot etc or Act as the Town shall think proper when met

At a Meeting of the Qualified Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury legally assembled on Monday the 3^d day of April 1786 for the purpose of bringing in their Votes for a Governor Lt Governor & Senators for the Year ensuing as directed & provided for by the Constitution said Inhabitants proceeded & brought in their Votes as follows Viz:

For Hon Oliver Prescott Esq ^r	10 Votes
For Mr John Maynard	1 Vote
