Sudbury August 21-1786 This notification has been posted up agreeable to the Order of the Town

At a Town Meeting regularly assembled at Sudbury on Monday the 21st day of August A.D. 1786 the Town being met according to the foregoing Notification, by their Vote accepted the warning of this Meeting
Article 1st Chose Col Jonathan Nye their Moderator

The remainder of this Article passed in the Negative
Article 2 The Town chose Mr Tho^s Walker, Capt W^m Samuel

Wheeler & Mr Isaac Maynard a Committee to confer with Capt Moulton upon the subject matter contained in this Article with orders to report at this Meeting, which Committee afterward Reported that they had agreed that the aforementioned warrant of Distress should be discharged upon said Moulton, paying the Treasurer Five pounds fourteen shillings specie, receipting to the Town for thirty six shillings due to his Father for Boarding Sarah Cory and giving up a certain Order drawn by the Selectmen of Sudbury in favour of one Joseph Dudley for ^{about} eighty ~~and~~ pounds in paper Money and also paying the Officer his fee and this to be a final settlement of the Differences subsisting between said Town & said Moulton; said Moulton being personally present and assenting thereto, the Town accepted the foregoing Report & ordered it to be recorded

Then the Town by their Vote dissolved this Meeting
