At a Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday
the 9th day of October 1786 the Town being met Accord-
ing to the foregoing warning made Choice of
Col Jonathan Nye for their Moderator
Then Voted, that this Town will to the utmost of their
power support the Federal Union of the United
States of America, & the Constitution of this
Commonwealth in particular

Then the Town Voted to give Instructions to their
Representative -
