who are Qualified as the Law directs to Vote in town
affairs to meet at the Meeting House in said Town
on Monday the 6th day of November next at
1 of the Clock in the afternoon on said Day then
and there

1st To choose a Moderator & bring in Town Debts
and Credit

2nd To see if the Town will Grant to their Reverend
Minister his Sallery for the year ensuing & make
provision for the Reasonable Collection of the same
do or act any other way on this Article as the
Town shall think proper when met

3rd To see if the Town agreeable to the Request of
Thomas Plympton Esq^r will desire the Committee
of said Town to Lay before the Town their Claim
to Lancaster Road so called now in dispute
between Col. Ezechiel How & said Town: Also to
desire Col. How to Lay his Claim to said Road
before the Town in order to the Towns having a
full understanding of the matter & to do or act
as the Town shall think proper when met

4th To see if the Town will Grant money to raise the
Cusway on the New County Road leading from Cedar
Swamp to Heyward Mills do or act as they shall
think proper when met

5th To see if the Town will make provision for
supplying the Deficiency in their Stock of amuni-
tion if any there be do or act as they shall think
proper when met

6th To see if the Town agreeable to the request of Mr
Josiah Richardson, a former Constable of said
Town, will take measures in order to Compromise
the Difference subsisting between them respect-
ing the Ballance due from said Richardson
to said Town, do or act as the Town shall think
proper when met
