Col. Price to the Town of Four pounds & six pence. After settling two accounts against the Town viz One in favour of Capt Daniel Bowker the other in favour of Lt Joseph Haywood: which report was accepted by the Town —

Allowed to Col. Price for procuring the line between Sudbury & Concord, for powder and Tools to blow Rocks five Shillings —

Then the Town ordered the Bills of Costs in the Actions of Taft, Willis & Moore vs said Town to be paid out of any unappropriated money that may be in the Treasury —

Then the Town allowed to Capt John Voyce Interest on an Order in his favour for about Nineteen pound dated 3 May 1786. till paid

Then the Town ordered the Assessors to make the money granted at this meeting into a Rate forthwith —

Then the Town by their vote dissolved this meeting
