The Town, being Met, agreeable to the foregoing Warning, proceeded to bring in their Votes for a County Treasurer, V^{ice} for Ebenezer Bridge Esq^r 12 Votes.

Art^{le} 1st The Town chose Doct^r Moses Taft, for their Moderator.

Then proceeded to the choice of a Town Clerk, which by an act of the General Court, passed March 23rd 1786, is the Officer, first to be chosen; & by a Majority of Votes, made choice of Doct^r Moses Taft, for their Clerk, the ensuing year.
