Then the Town, Voted to excuse Mr. Aaron Goodenow Junr from the Office of Constable, the present year.

Then the Town, passed a Vote, Viz^t That the Surveyors, of High Ways, should, at a Time, to be affixed: - make a Return, to the Assessors, of that part of their respective Taxes, which should not be worked out, according to the intended purpose: & add the same, to the Delinquents next Town Tax. - - -

Then the Town, proceeded, to the choice of a Constable, for the South Ward, & Mr. Isaac Lincoln Junr was chosen. Then the Town, voted to excuse Mr. Isaac Lincoln Junr from the Office of Constable, the present year. - - -

Then the Town, again proceeded, to the Choice, of a Constable, for the South Ward, & Mr. John Perry, was chosen.

6th The Town Voted, to accept the Settlement, of the Selectmen, with the Town Treasurer, & order'd the same to be Recorded: - Which Record, is afterwards inserted. - -

7th Voted to accept, the Contents, of this Article, as express'd in the Warning: - Agreeable to the Petition of James Norman: & others: - which Petition, is as follows.

Viz^t To, the Gentlemen Selectmen, of the Town of Sudbury, We desire, that you would put it, into the Warning of your next Town Meeting, to see, if the Town, will, by their Vote, desire the Selectmen, to begin their Town Meetings for the future: - at the Time, they shall appoint s^d Meetings to begin: & to see if the Town, will pass their Vote, - that no Vote shall be pass'd, after Day-light, is gone: - in s^d Meetings.
