9th Then the Town, agreeable to this Article, Voted, That the Town Treasurer, is hereby Directed to Issue his Execution, against all Delinquent Constables, unless s^d Delinquents, - shall settle their Delinquency, with him, - within the Term, of six Months.

Then the Town, accepted Lieut Asher Cutler, as a Constable, for the South Ward, the present Year, in the Stead, of Mr John Perry. ---
s^d Cutler, has since been sworn into Office.

10th Voted the Contents of this Article, as express'd in the Warrant. ---

Then, The Town, by their Vote dissolved this Meeting.
