

March Anno Domini, 1787

These, are to Notify, & Warn, all the Male Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as is provided by the Constitution, to Vote, in the Choice, of a Governor, Lt Governor, & Senators, for the Year ensuing; --- And all others, Qualified, as the Law directs, to Vote, in Town Affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House, in sd Town, on Monday, the 2^d Day, of April Next, at 1 O'clock, afternoon: --- on sd Day, then & there; ---

Articles

- 1st To, bring in their Votes, for a Governor, Lt Governor, and Senators, for the Year ensuing. ---
- 2^d To, choose a Moderator. --- Also, an Assessor, in the stead, of Mr Daniel Loring, who, is exempted, by Law from serving, in that Capacity, the present Year, Likewise to fill up, the Deficiency, of those other Town Officers, who, shall refuse or neglect, to take the Oath, annexed, to their respective Offices. ---
- 3rd To, see, if the Town, will grant, a Bounty, of One Dollar, per Man, to their Quota of Soldiers, who have of late, served the Term, of 30 Days, in the Service of this Commonwealth, --- Do, or act, on this Article, as the Town, shall think proper, when Mett. ---
- 4th To, see, if the Town, will Order, that suitable Materials, be provided, at the Town's expense; --- for the purpose, of employing, the poor, of said Town. --- Do, or act, any other way, on this Article, as the Town shall think proper, when Mett. ---
- 5th To, see, if the Town, will Dispose, of Two Army Notes (so called) now in the Treasury: --- amounting collectively, to £ 12. 5. 2 --- one of which became payable Jan'y 4th 1785 --- the other Jan'y 1st 1786. --- Do, or act, on this Article, as the Town, shall think proper, when Mett. ---
- 6th To, see, if the Town, at the Request, of Lieut. Vriah Moore, will give liberty, for him to erect, a Gate, at each Avenue, of the Road, leading by his House, During the Pleasure, of the Town: --- Do, or act, on this Article, as the Town, shall think proper, when Mett. ---
