Also, chose Mr Charles Hagner, as an Assessor, the present year, in the stead of Mr Daniel Spring, exempted by Law from serving. ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

3^d Granted, the sum of Nine pounds, for the purpose of replacing the Money, formerly advanced, by Individuals, to their Quota, of Soldiers, lately, in the service, of this Commonwealth, for 30 Days; - & for paying those Soldiers, One Dollar, each, - to whom that sum, was not advanced, previous to their marching. ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

6th Then the Town, passed on, to a consideration, of the 6th Article; & granted the contents, to the S^d Uriah, with this proviso, annex^d, - Viz^t That he support, the Bridge, near, his House, & keep the same, in good repair: - for & during the Time, the Road, is so shut up.

Then the Town, Voted, to refer, the latter clause, in the 2^d Article: - together with the 4th & 5th Articles, in the Warning: - to their Annual Meeting, in May next. ~ ~ ~

Then the Town, by their Vote, Dissolved this Meeting. ~ ~ ~
