{ The Town Officers, having this Mark (x) prefix'd
to their Names, have taken the Oath, annex'd
to their respective Offices. ---
Moses Taffs, Jr. Clerk.

These are to Notify and Warn, all the Freholders,
and other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified
according to the Constitution, to Vote, in the Choice of a
Representative, and all Others Qualified as the Law
directs, to Vote in Town Affairs, to Meet at the Meeting
House, in S^d Town, on Monday the 7th Day of May
next, at 1 O'clock, Afternoon, on S^d Day, then & there,

1st To elect & depute, some suitable & judicious Person,
being a Freholder & Resident, in S^d Town, to serve for
& represent, S^d Town, in a Great & General Court,
Appointed to be Conven'd, held, & kept, for the Service of
this Commonwealth at the State House, in Boston,
on Wednesday the 30th Day of May next, agreeable to a
Law, of the Commonwealth, in that behalf made &
provided. ---

2^d To Chuse a Moderator and to Act on the 4th & 5th Articles
refer'd from the Warding of April Meeting, to the Annual
May Meeting. ---

3^d To see if the Town, will Appoint a Committee for the
purpose of making a Settlement with Daniel Lincoln, re-
lative to the price of a Number of Cattle, due to him by an
Obligation, from S^d Town, likewise, to see if the Town, will
make provision, for paying him the Interest on S^d Obligation,
Do, or Act, in any other Way, on this Article, as the Town
shall think proper when Met. ---

4th To see if the Town will, at the Request of M^r Samuel
& Daniel Osborn, relinquish to them, their Proportion
of High-way Rates, During the Town's Pleasure, in
Consequence of their Supporting, the Causey & Bridge,
over Hop-Brook (so called) - Do or Act, as the Town
shall think proper, when Met. --- 194.1

5th To see if the Town, will Appoint a Committee, to
join, with a Committee, chosen by East-Sudbury, to
