2^d Chose William Pine Esq^r Moderator. And also Voted to provide a Quantity of Flax, at the Expence of the Town:— for the Employment, of the Poor, of S^d Town. & also, Voted, to refer, the Matter, (as to the Quantity, of the Flax:—) to the Prudence, & Discretion, of the Selectmen. Then One Motion, being Made, & seconded, the Question was put, to see if the Town, would Dispose, of the Army Notes, as mentioned, in this Article & it pass'd, in the Negative. — — — — —

3^d Then the Town, ^{by their Vote} Order'd, that Two entire Obligations, Collectively to the Amount, of £50. One Obligation to the Value of £30. the other to the Value of £20. now in the Treasury, & Due from the Town, of Bolton, to the Town, of Sudbury:— be Appropriated, towards the Discharge, of the Obligation due from the Town, to Daniel Lincoln, as mentioned in this Article:— And empower'd the Selectmen, to receive the Obligations afores^d from the Treasurer, & make settlement, with the S^d Lincoln. — — — — —

4th The Town, granted, Mess^{rs} Osborn's request, as express'd in this Article. — — — — —

5th The Town, Voted, to choose a Committee, for the purpose, mentioned in this Article:— and Capt^l Asahel Wheeler, M^r Thomas Walter, & M^r James Thompson, were chosen. — — — — —

6th Then the Town, by Vote, Order'd their Assessors, to make the Money, mentioned, in this Article, into a Note, at some convenient Opportunity. — — — — —

7th The Town Voted, that the Contents of this Article, subside be waived, for the present. — — — — —

Then the Town, by their Vote, dissolved this Meeting.
