Person, or Persons, to appear, in Behalf, of the Inhabitants of
S^d. Town, before Artemas Ward jun^r. Esq^r. at his Dwelling House,
in Weston, on the 20th of this instant August, at 2 O'clock, in
the Afternoon, — then, & there, to answer, to Nathan Smith, of
Birmingham, Inholders in a Plea of Trepass, — and
also, to appear, at any other Time & place, in Behalf of
the S^d. Inhabitants, & for the afores^d. purpose, should it be
deem'd Necessary. — Do or act, any other way, on this Article,
as the Town, shall think proper when met. —
