

October Anno Domini 1787

These are to Notify, & Warn, all the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, who are Qualified, as the Law directs, to Vote in Town Affairs, to meet at the Meeting House, in S^d Town, on Monday, the 15th Day, of this inst^t October, at 9 o'clock, in the forenoon, on S^d Day, then and there.

Article

- 1st To, Choose a Moderator, & bring in Town Debts & Credit.
- 2nd To see if the Town, will Grant, to their Rev^d Minister, his Salary, for the Year ensuing: & make Provision, for the Seasonable Collection, of the Sack: Do or Act, any other Way, on this Article, as the Town, shall think proper, when Met.
- 3rd To see, if the Town, will grant Money, to raise the Causey, on the New County = Road, leading from Cedar = Swamp, to Heyward = Mills, Do or Act, as the Town, shall think proper, when Met.
- 4th To see, if the Town, will Choose a Committee, for the purpose, of calling to Account, those Persons, to whose Care, the Town's Stock, of Ammunition, hath been of late intrusted, as to the present Deficiency, of the S^d Stock: Do or Act, as the Town shall think proper, when Met.
- 5th To see, if the Town, will make Provision, for the repairing, or rebuilding, the Canal = Bridge, & their Proportion of Shelburne's = Bridge (so called) Do or Act, as the Town, shall think proper when Met.
- 6th To see, if the Town, will make Provision, for supplying their Rev^d Minister, with a Quantity of Wood, necessary for the Approaching Winter: Do or Act, as the Town, shall think proper when Met.
- 7th To see, if the Town, will grant Money, for the Support, of a Grammar School, the coming Year, & order, where the same shall be kept.
- 8th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, for the Support, of a Reading & Writing School, the Year ensuing, & order, where the same, shall be kept.
- 9th To see, if the Town, will grant Money, for the Relief of the Poor, in S^d Town, the Year ensuing.
- 10th To see, if the Town, will grant Money, to pay their Assessors & Treasurer, the present Year.
- 11th To see, if the Town, will Appoint a Man, to take Care of, & sweep, the Meeting = House, Ring the Bell, & Dig Graves, as = Occasion may be, the Year ensuing.
