15th October, 1787 This Notification, has been Posted, agreeable to the

The Town, by their Vote, accepted the Warning, of this Meeting.

Monday October 15th 1787. The Town, being Mett, according
Article 1st Article, & Choose, Mr Thomas Walker for their Moderator,
1st then Discounted, & Allowed, the following: ————— VLDth

{ Discounted to Leis^t Oliver Noyes for Jonathan Benjamin
Rates for 1783 One pound three shillings
also for Daniel Moore's Rates in the same year four shillings
& three pence ————— £ 1^{..} 7^{..} 3

Allowed to Mirah Balcom for work on the Southwest
School House & for blowing Rocks three shillings ————— 0 3 0

" To Asahel Gibbs for Sixty feet of two & half Inch Oak
planks Five shillings & six pence ————— 0 5 6

2 Then passed on to the second Article, And granted
the sum of Seventy four pound as a Salary
for the Reverend Minister for the ensuing Year
The Town by their Vote waived the mode of
collecting the aforesaid Salary for the present 74 0 0

3 The Town by Vote passed Over the third Article
for the present —————

4 And passed on to the fourth & voted to choose
five persons as a Committee for the purpose
expressed in said Article and the five Select

men were chosen

Then { Discounted to Constable Benjamin Smith
for Reuben Moore's Rates for Seventeen hundred
th & eighty five four shillings & six pence 4/6

5 — Voted to Rebuild the Canal Bridge forth
with & Chose the Select men & a Committee
for the said purpose, the Voted to defer the
making a grant for enabling the Committee
to prosecute said business till some future
opportunity.
