 Then voted to Adjourn this Meeting four Weeks from
 the present day at One O'Clock after noon then
 to meet at the same place

Monday November 12. 1787th The Town being met
 according to the foregoing Adjournment proce-
 ded as follows

The Town took up the latter Clause of the second
 Article and voted not to have the Ministers
 salary made into a Separate Rate the ensuing
 Year

Then the Town took up the third Article & voted
 that Col. Rice One of the Highway Surveyors
 for the present Year should Cause Leid Joseph
 Haywood and some others adjacent to work
 out their Highway Rates or delinquency of
 said Rates at the Causeway leading from Cedar
 Swamp to Haywards Mills

Allowed to W. Isaac Maynard thirteen shillings & four
 pence he giving up an order against the
 Town for the same sum

discounted to Constable Peter Haynes for Samuel
 Wymans Rates for Seventeen Hundred & eighty
 three Seven shillings & five pence 7/5
 Also for Ashbell & William Moore's Rates
 the same Year Two pound six shillings
 £2. 13. 5

Allowed Josiah Goodenow for one days work for him
 self & Boat for securing the plank at the
 Canal Bridge &c. four shillings

Allowed Constable Asper Cutter for Transporting
 Mary Giles to East Sudbury four shillings

Allowed Nisha Goodenow for five Quoir & four sheets
 of Cartridge paper & two shillings & seven pence &
 three Knott thread six pence April 21st & July 3rd to
 Sundry Articles six shillings 9/1

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
