These are, to Notify & Warn, all the Freeholders, & other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury: Qualified, according to Law, to Vote, in the Election, of Representatives; & all others, Qualified, as the Law directs: - to Vote, in Town Affairs: to Meet, at the Meeting = House, in said Town: - on Monday the 10th Day of this instant Decem^r at 1 o'clock ^{afternoon} on T^h Day: - then & thence,

Article 1st To Elect, or choose a Delegate, to represent, said Town, in a Convention, to Meet, at the State = House, in Boston, on the second Wednesday of January next: for the purpose of Assembling with, & Ratifying the Constitution, of Frame of Government, as reported, by the late Federal Convention, Agreeable, to a Resolution, of the Hon^{ble} Legislature, of the 23th of October last. - - -

Article 2^d To choose a Moderator, & Sec^y of the Town, with choose, a Surveyor of Highways: Do, or act, as the Town, shall think proper, when met. - - -
