

March Anno Domini 1788

These, are to Notify, & Warn, all the Freeholders, & other Qual-
-ified, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, as the Law directs, to Vote
in Town Affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House, in s^d Town, on
Monday, the 3^d Day of March next, at 1 O'Clock, in the Afternoon,
on s^d Day. — then and there.

Article 1st / To choose a Moderator, Selectmen, Town Clerk,
Town Treasurer, Assessors, Constables, and all other Town
Officers, required, by Law, to be Annually chosen, in the
Months of March, or April.

2^d To see, if the Town, will repair their Highways, by a
Vote, the present Year, and grant a suitable Sum, of
Money, for repairing the same. Do or act, &c

3^d To see, if the Town, will give Liberty for Horses to go, at
large, the present Year.

4th To see, if the Town, will give Liberty for Horses, to go,
at large, without fetters, any part, of the present Year,
from the 1st Day of April, next, to the last Day of Sep-
-tember next.

5th To see, if the Town, will give Liberty, for Sheep, to go, at
large, from the 15th Day of March, to the first Day of
May next.

6th To see, if the Town, will Accept, of the Settlement, of
the Town Treasurer, with the Selectmen, and Order
the same to be recorded.

7th To see, if the Town, will take into their Considera-
-tion, the Purport, of a Certificate, procur'd by James
Demander from the Secretary of this Commonwealth,
reference being had to the said Certificate, Do, or act, &c

8th To see, if the Town, will, agreeable to the Request, of
Joseph Curtis Esq^r — Empower their Committee, cho-
-sen, to call in the Receipts, given by Saldiers, to pay
them, for their Services in the Continental Army, to put
in Suit, the Receipts, given by the Selectmen, for Money
drawn out, of the Treasury, before the Town of Sudbury
was Divided, & to prosecute, to final Judgment, &
Execution, — Do, or act, &c

9th To see, if the Town, will give Any Directions, to their
Selectmen, relative to the laying out a Road or Passway,
to & from, sundry Lots of Meadow, lying in Ware, &
Gulph Meadows, — agreeable to the petition, of William
Parkman & others, reference being had to the said petition
Do or act, &c
