

March, Anno Domini, 1788

10th To See if the Town will grant, to Samuel Daken & others, Petitioners, the privilege of putting down a Ware, in the great River, in S^d Town, Do or act, &c

11th To See if the Town, will grant to Jonathan Fairbank the Liberty, of turning, or altering the Road, near his House, agreeable to the request of Samuel Knight & others. Do or act, &c

12th To See, if the Town, will Order, that those Persons, who shall in future be chosen, as Constables, or collectors of Taxes, & shall hire, the S^d service done by another, shall Indemnify the Town, Do or Act, &c

13th To See, if the Town will Order, the Selectmen, to Deliver up, to Josiah Richardson, & others, the Receipts formerly given by them, for the Reception of Ammunition, belonging to the Town. Do or Act, &c

14th To See, if the Town, will Choose a Committee, to go in a Committee, chosen by East Sudbury, for the purpose of repairing or rebuilding, Sherman's Bridge, &c, &c Do or Act, &c

15th To See, if the Town will Ratify, a Vote, of the School Ward, in the South East, part, of the Town, relative to the Grants, of Town, made, or which shall be made to that Ward, for School Keeping. Do or Act, &c

16th To See if the Town will Choose a Committee, for the purpose, of disposing, of the Work-House, in S^d Town, Do or Act, &c
