The Town chose Col^l. Jonathan Price, for their Moderator. — Who chose M^r. Elisha How, a Selectman, in the Room of Cap^t. Abel Thompson, who declined serving.

Then, the Town, attended to the 13th Article, as included, within this 2^d Article: — & Chose M^r. John Maynard, — M^r. Thomas Walker, & Col^l. Jon^l. Price as a Committee, to examine into ^{the} Matter, of the 1st Article: — & the report at a future Meeting.

Then Col^l. Price, Accepted the Office of Constable, to serve in person, & procure a Man, to the Acceptance of the Town, to the 1st Trust & Office.

Then M^r. Isaac Lincoln Ind^t came into Town Meeting, & refused to take the Oath, Annexed to the Office of Constable.

Then the Town, Voted to go on, & choose a Constable, for the South Ward, in the Room, of M^r. Isaac Lincoln Ind^t & made choice of M^r. David How Ind^t to the 1st Office, the ensuing Year. — Then the Town excused M^r. David How, Ind^t from serving as Constable the present Year.

Then the Town chose Cap^t. Augustus Moore, as a Constable for the south Ward, the present Year. 2111

3rd Then the Town, voted that the Disposal of the Water House be deferred, till May Meeting, and also, instructed their Selectmen, in the mean while to use their best endeavor — to put out those Children, which are at the Water House, and of suitable age.
