Monday 12th May - The Town, being Mett, at Nine and Place
agreeable to the foregoing Warrant - Proceeded, &
Article Chose William Price Esq^r a Freeholder & Resident
1st in S^d Town: - to serve for, & the present S^d Town, in
General Court, the ensuing Year. - - - -

2nd Chose William Price Esq^r Moderator - and then
attended, to the latter Clause of S^d Article - & Chose
Mr Daniel Osborn, as a Constable for the South Ward,
the ~~present~~^{ensuing} Year - in the Room of Capt Augustus
Moore - exempted by Law, from serving. - - - -

Then Mr Daniel Osborn, came into Town Meeting
& Declared, his Non-acceptance, to the S^d Office. -

Then, the Town proceeded, & Chose Mr Elisha Goodenow,
as a Constable for the South Ward, the ensuing Year. -

The remainder of S^d Article, pass'd over, for the present. -

3rd Then the Town Voted, to pass over this Article. - - - -

4th Then the Town Voted, to give in, to Asahel Gibbs, his Rates
agreeable to the Apportionments, now in the Hands of
Com^{ble} Jacob Mead, and Com^{ble} John Goodenow,
the S^d Gibbs relinquishing his Claim, as expres'd
in the S^d Article. - - - -

5th Voted to Chose a Committee of five Persons, for the
purpose expres'd in this Article. - & Capt Asahel Wheeler,
Mr John Maynard, Capt Augustus Moore, - Col^{le}
Ezekiel How, & Capt Elijah Smith, were chosen. -

6th Then the Town Voted, to pass over this Article for
the present. - - - -

213 Then the Town reconsidered their Vote, relative to
the 5th Article. - - And Voted to Chose a Committee
of two Persons, for the purposes of S^d Article - And
Capt Asahel Wheeler, and William Price Esq^r were
chosen. - Then the Town Order'd the S^d Committee or
either of them, to prosecute the Matter, to final Judge-
ment, if in their Opinions. it would promote the
Town's interest. - - - -
