Then the Question, was put, to see if the Town would accept of Mr. Thomas Price as a Constable for the North Ward, the ~~present~~ ^{present} Year, in the stead of Col^d Price, formerly chosen: - & the Question was'd in the Negative. - - - - -

Then the Town, at Col^d Price's request, gave per-
-mission, for him, to make further trial - as to procuring a Man, to the Office of Constable, & present him to the Selectmen, for their Acceptance, & the Selectmen taking Bond of the person presented: - the Selectmen's Acceptance, to entitle him, (that is Col^d Price) to every privilege of the Town's Acceptance, provided the person, be presented, & accepted, before the Next Taxes, and ready for Commitment. - - - - -

Then the Town, Voted to adjourn this Meeting to Monday 26th instant, 5 O'clock Afternoon, then to meet at the same place. - - - - -

Monday 26th May. - The Town being Mett, according to the foregoing Adjournment, - Attended to Mr. Elisha Goodenow's Plea, in excuse, for his not accepting the Office of Constable: - which Plea appear'd insufficient to the Town: - - - - -

Then Mr. Elisha Goodenow, in the presence of the Town, declared his Non-acceptance to the S^d Office. - - - - -

Then the Town, chose Mr. Daniel Woodward Moore, as a Constable for the South Ward, the present Year. - - - - -

Then Mr. Daniel Woodward Moore, came into Town Meeting, & declared his Non Acceptance of the S^d Office. - - - - -

Then the Town, proceeded, & chose Mr. William Brown, as a Constable for the South Ward the pre-
-sent Year. - - - - -

Then the Town Voted, to adjourn this Meeting to Monday the 2^d Day of June Next, 4 O'clock Afternoon, then to meet at the same place. - - - - -
